What is an alternating pressure mattress?

An alternating pressure mattress is a specialized medical device designed to prevent and treat pressure ulcers.

It achieves this by periodically redistributing pressure across the surface of the mattress.

The internal air cells cyclically inflate and deflate.

This process changes the points of contact between the patient's body and the mattress surface, thereby redistributing pressure and improving blood flow to the skin and underlying tissues.

Who needs alternating pressure mattress?

Patients who are at high risk of developing pressure ulcers typically require an alternating pressure mattress.

This includes individuals who are:

- Bedridden or immobile patients who are unable to change their position frequently.
- Elderly, as aging skin is more susceptible to pressure damage.
- Limited or no ability to move parts of their body.
- Suffering from severe illness or injury, resulting in prolonged bed rest.
- Suffering from existing pressure ulcers, as this helps prevent further damage and aid in healing.
