Since then, the Biennial Technical Visit has been the most important and prestigious event on the YP-Com calendar. Past BTV's include tours to the Venice Locks (Italy), Danube River Integration System (Austria), Maasvlakte 2 (The Netherlands), Panama Locks (Panama), Port of Ghent (Belgium), Great Barrier Reef and several port developments in Sydney and Cairns (Australia).
